DIRECTIONS TO THE BOISE GUN CLUB

From the East

Exit 64 from I-84 at Black's Creek-Kuna Exit and travel west on Kuna-Mora Road for 6 miles or exit on the Gowen Road Exit and travel Gowen Road west for 3 miles, then go south on Pleasant Valley Road for 6 miles to Kuna-Mora Road then east 1 mile.

From the West:

From I-84 take Orchard (#52) exit. Go south on Orchard. Orchard Street merges with Gowen Road and turns south-east. Follow traffic along Gowen Road approximately $\frac{1}{4}$ mile to Pleasant Valley Road. Turn south on Pleasant Valley Road for approximately 6 miles to Kuna-Mora Road. (You will pass the Idaho State Prison). At the intersection of Pleasant Valley and Kuna-Mora Road, turn east on Kuna-Mora Road. The club is on the north side of the road approximately $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile east of the intersection.

ISTA Congratulates 2019 ATA All Americans from Idaho

Update on implementation of the ISTA Constitutional Amendment adopted May 26, 2019.

An ISTA Constitutional Change adopted in 2019 resulted in a phased in process to reach the status of electing one director for each zone each year. The objective in this change was to enhance the Board of Director's capability of meeting the state objective of the organization which is to: "promote the interest of Trapshooting and to make all regulations pertaining thereto". This responsibility requires that the Board of Directors act in such a manner as to promote and support the sport throughout the State of Idaho. It is the full membership that elects all members of the Board, not just the membership of the zone. The adopted change to the constitution ensures that prospective members of the Board are representative of the entire ISTA membership. The change assures greater statewide continuity of the state wide Board of Directors by assuring that at any time there are Directors from each zone who have experience in enacting the role of the Board.

Article IV Section 2: There shall be a Board of nine (9) Directors, the President and Vice President to be members of said Board. The State shall be divided into three (3) zones as follows:

Northern zone will provide three (3) Directors, Southeastern zone will provide three (3) Directors and the Southwest zone will provide three (3) Directors. The Directors shall be elected for a three (3) year term, during the State Shoot. One Director for each zone will be elected each year. The State Delegate is a non-voting member of the Board.

VOICE RELEASE SYSTEMS WILL BE USED ON ALL TRAPS!

REGISTRATION

Registration and Squadding will be available 1 to 6 pm May 21, 2020 and beginning 7:30 A.M. each morning of the shoot.

1. Take your ATA card to the handicap table. Have your average card ready, with all averages up to date, including a doubles average. (Note: 3S Shooting Software may be used to determine ATA shooting history and class eligibility). **If you have a PITA card, it is your responsibility to present it at the handicap table and if desired, to notify the cashier to Cross-Register your targets.)**
2. Specialty Classes: It is your responsibility to notify the handicap committee of your special classification
LD1, LD2, SR VT, SUB VT, VET, JR, SUB JR, JR GOLD
3. Select events, purses and options prior to arriving at the cashing windows.
4. Go to Squadding Window for squad assignments
5. Take all forms to the cashing window. Make all checks payable to the Idaho State Trapshooting Association (ISTA).

Any shooter who wishes to squad another shooter must have the second shooter's permission, and the necessary forms (average card, plastic card, ATA number etc.) to facilitate the handicapping process.

SHOOT RULES AND INFORMATION

ADVANCE SQUADDING

This is encouraged, and can be done at www.Presquad.com. You must still go through the Handicap Table upon arrival at the club.

SCORERS & SCORING

Your score will be called at the end of each 5 shots, 10 for Doubles. It is the duty of the contestant to have any error corrected before he/she has fired the first shot at the succeeding position or in the case of his last post before he/she leaves the trap. No corrections for mismarked targets can be made after the squad has departed the trap.

TARGET SETTING

Target setting will be under the direction of the ISTA and the Boise Gun Club. No targets will be changed without permission from an ISTA or Boise Gun Club Director.

REFUNDS

No entry fees, purses or options will be refunded after the event has started. All refunds will be mailed to the shooters with the payoffs.

LATE SHOOTERS

Watch your squad number. No Shooter will be called on the speaker. Shooters missing their squad will be re-squadded only if they pay a \$10.00 re-squadding fee. There will be NO waiting period.

ATA POINTS

Maximum ATA points for resident and non-resident shooters will be available at this shoot. Please read the current rules regarding awarding of points.

MONEY DIVISION

All purses and added money divided High Gun System unless otherwise noted. No Monies can be played after the first squad takes the line.

STATE TEAM RACE

Must consist of one AA, one A, one B, one C, and one D shooter. A lower class shooter can move up classes. Team must enter before first half of singles race starts. One Team per Idaho Club.

SHOOTOFFS

All preliminary event ties will be carried over to the next like event, unless a shoot off is needed because of a change in yardage (i.e. a tie results in earned yardage) There will be a shoot off held for Championship Events. A shoot off committee of the ISTA Directors and State Delegate will conduct and oversee all shoot offs. Please see them for any information concerning shoot offs.

NOTE: REASONABLE EFFORT WILL BE MADE TO NOTIFY YOU OF A SHOOT OFF, HOWEVER YOU MUST BE PRESENT WHEN CALLED OR FORFEIT.

NOTE: CHANGES FOR HOA AND HAA SCORES

High Over All and High All Around scores will be computed by the cashier and posted following Event #9. Shooters will be responsible for checking these sheets for errors and notify the score board personnel. The 16 yard classification of a shooter in Event #1 will be used to determine HOA classification.

PAYOFF

All payoffs will be posted as soon as possible following the event. All shooters will receive a payoff sheet following the shoot. Payoffs will be made by check and mailed to shooters.

Classification

PENALTY YARDAGE AND CLASSIFICATION

The handicap committee may assign a MINIMUM of 22 yards and Class B Singles and Class B Doubles to any shooter who does not have an established shooting history; however, any trapshooting history may be used to establish classification and yardage. In all cases, known ability will have a strong bearing on classification. A shooter belonging to another shooting association will be required to shoot from his or her longest yardage. Any questions may be referred to the Handicap Committee for evaluation.

TROPHIES

Trophies will be awarded at the conclusion of shooting each day; it is the shooters responsibility to make arrangements for someone to pick-up or arrange to have the trophies to be mailed if the shooter has to leave before the trophies are finalized. If trophies are mailed, shooter may be responsible for postage.

100 and 200 STRAIGHTS

The ISTA has 100 and 200 straight pins available. If you qualify, please see Joe Eichert or Spud Storey.

ALL AMERICAN POINTS WILL BE AVAILABLE IN ALL OF THE EVENTS AT THIS SHOOT

There is only one "type" of All American points now. There are no longer separate "trophy" points and "tie" points. Trophies are no longer required to be given in order for points to be awarded.

ALL shooters breaking the TOP THREE SCORES in Resident and Non-Resident special category will ALWAYS receive All American points. Please review Appendix II of the Official ATA rules for complete information regarding All American Points.



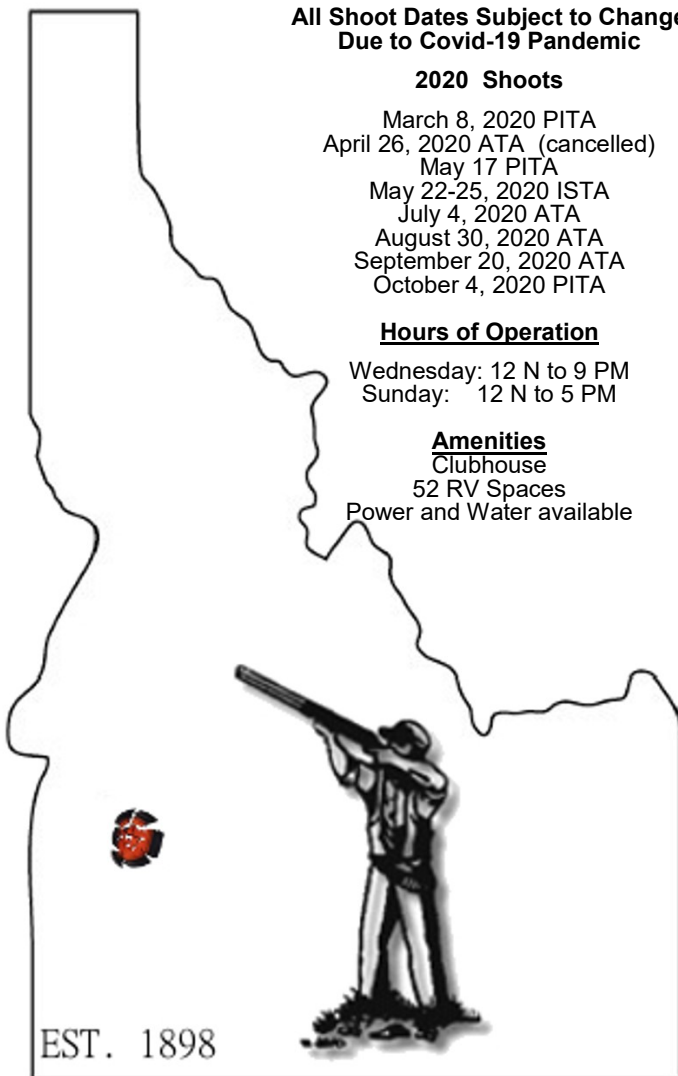
NOTICE OF TAXATION



The Internal Revenue Service (IRS) requires that anyone making \$600 or more at a shoot report those earnings to the IRS via the shoot host. In order for the shoot host to do this required reporting, we **MUST** have the Social Security Number (SSN) or Tax ID of the shooters that win \$600 or more. This is accomplished by completing an IRS Form W9. If you think you may have \$600 or more in winnings, please legibly complete a W9 form and return it to Joe Eichert or the Cashier's desk.

The Idaho Trapshooting Hall of Fame, formed in 1988, is a nonprofit organization with the following mission "To record and memorialize significant people, places and events in the history of trapshooting in the state of Idaho and to promote trapshooting and educate the public as to the values of the sport of and to preserve the history, records, artifacts and other memorabilia as well as to promote and provide inspiration to all trap shooters. Over the past 31 years 44 people have been inducted into the Idaho Hall of Fame, becoming part of the Idaho trapshooting legacy. The Idaho Trapshooting Hall of Fame offers college scholarships to high school senior who have actively participated in the sport of trapshooting. Application materials are available through any board member. Nominations for the Hall of Fame can be made for future induction consideration. Nominations are due by May 1st for the following year.

The Idaho Trapshooting raises funds to achieve the mission through fundraising, donations, Lewis Purses at Idaho trapshoots where a portion of the option fee is returned to the Hall of Fame. Funds are used for recognition events and scholarships.

You can send your donations to the Idaho Trapshooting Hall of Fame. You can also obtain scholarship and nomination forms from Sue, or any member of the Idaho Trapshooting Hall of Fame Board of Directors.

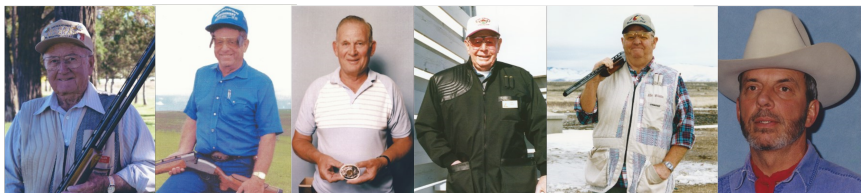

2020 Idaho Trapshooting Hall of Fame Inductee

The Hall of Fame Board would like to thank David Poseley's daughter Renae Poseley James for her wonderful effort to describe the history behind this year's inductee into the Hall of Fame. Please keep in mind that there is not enough space here to list all of the wins that David has brought home in the years he has been trap shooting.

It all began in 1958. At the age of 10 David began working at a trap club in Colorado as a puller. At that time, being a puller truly meant you were going to "pull" birds all day, and he worked for birds and not wages. There were no voice calls or buttons you could push, and he would pull a long bar back, and when the shooter yelled "pull," he would release it. Unfortunately, as it is today, kids couldn't afford this sport without the help of someone else. He was determined, even at his young age, not to be beholden to anyone, so he did the second-best thing—if he couldn't compete in the sport, he could work at a club and learn as much as he could about the sport from shooters. He has always had a love for guns, and trapshooting just called to him. That was the start of him becoming the great competitor and trapshooter he is today.



David has volunteered to teach children and adults how to shoot. If anyone he knows shows interest in this sport, he is the first to invite them to shoot, and offers to teach them. For a child shooting, David is the first to volunteer his time, his ammo, and a shotgun that is fit just for the child. The majority of people he has taught have become registered shooters, and still shoot trap to this day.

David has been deeply committed to going to as many competitions as he possibly can. Over the last 23 years he has traveled to Hawaii, Washington, Nevada, Utah, Arizona, Montana, and of course, all over the state of Idaho. During this time he had a very large number of wins, including wins at the Grand Pacific, the Idaho ATA state shoot, and the PITA state shoot.

Some of his major wins include:

- 2010 ATA Idaho State Handicap Champion (won four-way shoot off) with 97
- 2014 PITA Idaho State Singles Champion with 199
- 2015 Grand Pacific Veteran's Singles Champion with 198
- 2015 Tie for Champion of Champions at the Grand Pacific

David earned selection to the Idaho PITA All-Star team seven straight years—from 2010 through 2016, and was captain or co-captain three of those years.

He shot 100 straight from 27 yards at the Twin Falls Gun Club, one of only five in the entire PITA that year.

David has also fired at over 55,000 PITA registered targets, and many more with the ATA.

There is a draw score in each of the first 8 events including the 1st and 2nd 100 of the singles.

All participants' scores, excluding the high score, are entered into a drawing at no cost to the shooter.

If there is only one shooter with the drawn score, that person wins \$100. If there are more than one the shooters with the drawn score can participate in a Miss And Out Shoot Off at the end of the shoot day. The winner of the shoot off wins \$100. Wins are limited to one during the 4 day event. (Ties may split if they choose, but all persons with that score are then ineligible for future draws).

All Sub Junior and Junior Shooter scores are entered into another drawing at no cost to the shooter. If there is only one shooter with the drawn score, that person wins \$50. 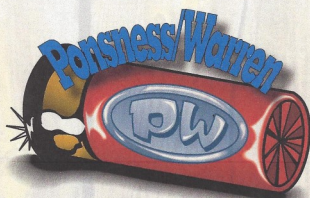
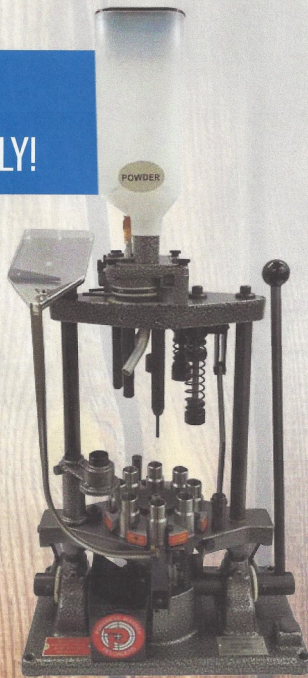

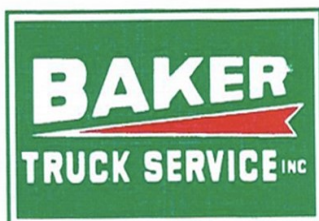

ATA DAILY FEES

The ATA in its program of building strong state associations, aids them financially; from the \$20 annual membership, \$2 is returned to the state organization. From the \$500 life membership, \$150 is returned to the state organization over a ten (10) year period & part is retained in a special ATA emergency fund. From the \$3 daily fee, twenty percent (20%) is returned to the state organization.

These refunds are made to the State Association ten days prior to the State Tournament, provided such tournament is held and provided the State turns into the ATA at least \$200 from annual membership dues and registration fees. From this refund, there will be deducted an amount equal to any fines due because of late shoot reports. On or before January 1 of each year the ATA shall inform the secretary of each State of the approximate amount of refund to be paid to that state.

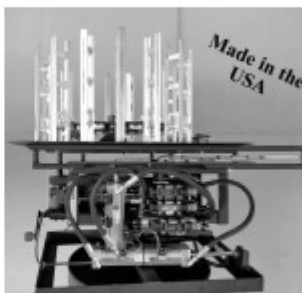

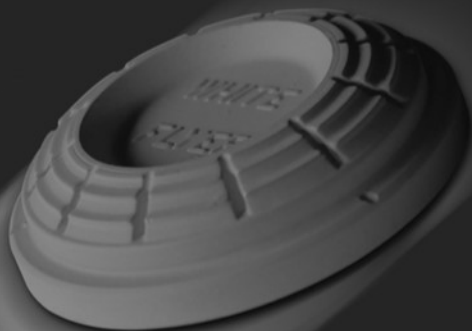
