## **SHOOT RULES AND INFORMATION**

### ***VOICE RELEASE SYSTEMS WILL BE USED ON ALL TRAPS!***

#### **REGISTRATION**

Registration and Squadding will be available 1 to 6 pm Thursday May 25, 2023 and beginning 7:30 A.M. each morning of the shoot.

1. Take your ATA card to the handicap table. Have your average card ready, with all averages up to date, including a doubles average. (Note: 3S Shooting Software may be used to determine ATA shooting history and class eligibility). **If you have a PITA card, it is your responsibility to present it at the handicap table and if desired, to notify the cashier to Cross-Register your targets.)**
2. Specialty Classes: It is your responsibility to notify the handicap committee of your special classification  
LD1, LD2, SUB VT, VET, SR VET, SUB JR, JR, JR GOLD
3. Select events, purses and options prior to arriving at the cashing windows.
4. Go to Squadding Window for squad assignments
5. Take all forms to the cashing window. Make all checks payable to the Idaho State Trapshooting Association (ISTA).

Any shooter who wishes to squad another shooter must have the second shooter's permission, and the necessary forms (average card, plastic card, ATA number etc.) to facilitate the handicapping process.

## **SHOOT RULES AND INFORMATION**

### **ADVANCE SQUADDING**

This is encouraged, and can be done at [www.Presquad.com](http://www.Presquad.com). You must still go through the Handicap Table upon arrival at the club.

### **SCORERS & SCORING**

Your score will be called at the end of each 5 shots, 10 for Doubles. It is the duty of the contestant to have any error corrected before he/she has fired the first shot at the succeeding position or in the case of his last post before he/she leaves the trap. No corrections for mismarked targets can be made after the squad has departed the trap.

### **TARGET SETTING**

Target setting will be under the direction of the ISTA and the Host Club. No targets will be changed without permission from an ISTA or Host Club Director.

### **REFUNDS**

No entry fees, purses or options will be refunded after the event has started. All refunds will be mailed to the shooters with the payoffs.

### **LATE SHOOTERS**

Watch your squad number. No Shooter will be called on the speaker. Shooters missing their squad will be re-squadded only if they pay a \$10.00 re-squadding fee. There will be NO waiting period.

### **ATA POINTS**

Maximum ATA points for resident and non-resident shooters will be available at this shoot. Please read the current rules regarding awarding of points.

### **MONEY DIVISION**

All purses and added money divided High Gun System unless otherwise noted. No Monies can be played after the first squad takes the line.

### **IDAHO CLUB TEAM RACE**

Must consist of one AA, one A, one B, one C, and one D shooter. A lower class shooter can move up classes. Team must enter before first half of singles race starts. One Team per Idaho Club.

### **SHOOTOFFS**

All preliminary event ties will be carried over to the next like event, unless a shoot off is needed because of a change in yardage (i.e. a tie results in earned yardage) There will be a shoot off held for Championship Events. A shoot off committee of the ISTA Directors and State Delegate will conduct and oversee all shoot offs. Please see them for any information concerning shoot offs.

NOTE: REASONABLE EFFORT WILL BE MADE TO NOTIFY YOU OF A SHOOT OFF, HOWEVER YOU MUST BE PRESENT WHEN CALLED OR FORFEIT.

### **NOTE: CHANGES FOR HOA AND HAA SCORES**

High Over All and High All Around scores will be computed by the cashier and posted following Event #10. Shooters will be responsible for checking these sheets for errors and notify the score board personnel. The 16 yard classification of a shooter in Event #1 will be used to determine HOA classification.

### **PAYOFF**

All payoffs will be posted as soon as possible following the event. All shooters will receive a payoff sheet following the shoot. Payoffs will be made by check and mailed to shooters.

# Classification

## PENALTY YARDAGE AND CLASSIFICATION

The handicap committee may assign a MINIMUM of 22 yards and Class B Singles and Class B Doubles to any shooter who does not have an established shooting history; however, any trapshooting history may be used to establish classification and yardage. In all cases, known ability will have a strong bearing on classification. A shooter belonging to another shooting association will be required to shoot from his or her longest yardage. Any questions may be referred to the Handicap Committee for evaluation.

### 16 YARD CLASSIFICATION

97% and over.....AA  
94% and under 97%..... A  
91% and under 94%.....B

### DOUBLES CLASSIFICATION

Five Classes

93% and over.....AA  
89% and under 93%.....A

78% and under 85%..... C  
Under 78%.....D

### TROPHIES

Trophies will be awarded at the conclusion of shooting each day; it is the shooters responsibility to make arrangements for someone to pick-up or arrange to have the trophies to be mailed if the shooter has to leave before the trophies are finalized. If trophies are mailed, shooter may be responsible for postage.

### 100 and 200 STRAIGHTS

The ISTA has 100 and 200 straight pins available. If you qualify, please see Kathy Connerley or Spud Storey.

#### ALL AMERICAN POINTS WILL BE AVAILABLE IN ALL OF THE EVENTS AT THIS SHOOT

There is only one "type" of All American points now. There are no longer separate "trophy" points and "tie" points.

Trophies are no longer required to be given in order for points to be awarded.

ALL shooters breaking the TOP THREE SCORES in Resident and Non-Resident special category will ALWAYS receive All American points. Please review Appendix II of the Official ATA rules for complete information regarding All American Points.



## NOTICE OF TAXATION



The Internal Revenue Service (IRS) requires that anyone making \$600 or more at a shoot report those earnings to the IRS via the shoot host. In order for the shoot host to do this required reporting, we **MUST** have the Social Security Number (SSN) or Tax ID of the shooters that win \$600 or more. This is accomplished by completing an IRS Form W9. If you think you may have \$600 or more in winnings, please legibly complete a W9 form and return it to Kathy Connerley or the Cashier's desk. Checks will not be mailed to winners of \$600 or more until a W9 is on file.

## IDAHO TRAPSHOOTING HALL OF FAME

The Idaho Trapshooting Hall of Fame, formed in 1988, is a nonprofit organization with the following mission "To record and memorialize significant people, places and events in the history of trapshooting in the state of Idaho and to promote trapshooting and educate the public as to the values of the sport of and to preserve the history, records, artifacts and other memorabilia as well as to promote and provide inspiration to all trap shooters. Over the past 33 years 45 people have been inducted into the Idaho Hall of Fame, becoming part of the Idaho trapshooting legacy. The Idaho Trapshooting Hall of Fame offers college scholarships to high school senior who have actively participated in the sport of trapshooting. Application materials are available through any board member. Nominations for the Hall of Fame can be made for future induction consideration. Nominations are due by May 1st for the following year.

The Idaho Trapshooting raises funds to achieve the mission through fundraising, donations, Lewis Purses at Idaho trap shoots where a portion of the option fee is returned to the Hall of Fame. Funds are used for recognition events and scholarships.

## IDAHO HALL OF FAME 2023 INDUCTEE

Kathleen Connerley is being inducted into the Idaho Hall of fame because of impressive impact that has made on Idaho trapshooting as a tireless volunteer for the betterment of the sport in the State of Idaho and as a fundraising phenom.

Kathy began her ATA registered shooting career in 1978 and has logged registered targets every year since. Subsequently, her PITA career began in 1997. To date she has shot 91,000 ATA and 14,525 PITA registered targets. She is an annual member to both associations. Her home club is the Culdesac Gun Club but she regularly renews yearly memberships at clubs across Idaho including Lewiston, Caldwell, and Boise. Over the years, Kathy has participated at shoots in many states around the country with husband, Spud and other family members. Currently, Kathy shoots mostly singles on squads with family and friends.

Kathy's true talent lies in her skills as an organizer and a fundraiser. She has coordinated, set up and advertised countless silent and live auctions, raffles, wine tastings, and dinners. She is famously the Queen of Raffle Ticket sales! Kathy may be small, but she is fierce. Just watch her in action for a few minutes at any shoot where she has her raffle tickets in hand and you will see many people just reach into their wallets with a smile to grab the twenties contained within because they hear her battle cry, "Hey, I need your twenty bucks!"

Since 2010 Kathy has used her talents to design, sew, and embroider the Idaho State Trapshooting Quilt that she then raffles off every year. She divides the proceeds and donates an equal share to the Idaho State Trapshooting Association and the ID PITA. To date she has donated more than \$25,000 to the two associations. In addition, Kathy had loaned her considerable fund-raising skills to help individual gun clubs, both state associations, and various youth trapshooting groups across the state. One example of this is in the early 2000's, the old Lewiston Gun Club needed to raise money for an imminent relocation. Kathy was instrumental in orchestrating at least two live auctions to benefit this cause. These auctions were held at the Camas Prairie Shoot under large outdoor tents and brought in a whopping \$13,000 to \$14,000 each! Of course, the ISTA and ID PITA silent auctions would not exist if it weren't for Kathy. Her ability to glean about \$3000 from others' donated items is nothing short of amazing. She also helped develop the Steele/Connerley draw score for the ISTA state shoot, and she and Spud sponsored Traps 1 & 4 of the ID PITA handicap marathon perpetual purses.

Kathy has been elected to many trapshooting boards. She has been on the ID PITA board of directors for five years and held the office of Vice President from 2017 to 2020. She was also a director on the ISTA board from 2012 to 2014 but currently volunteers her time to that organization by heading up the trophy committee for the ISTA state shoot and has been doing so for the past five years. She is currently the Secretary/Treasurer of her home club, Culdesac Gun Club, and has been for many years. She currently is Secretary-Treasurer of the ISTA. She has been an active Idaho representative at the Grand Pacific, has served on the PITA HOF board and is a regular attendee with her husband, Spud.

Kathy's knowledge of Roberts Rules of Order makes her a huge advocate for the trapshooting community to allow the membership to have a voice in how they want their organizations to be run during annual membership meetings. For many years, Kathy has worked tirelessly to unite all Idaho trap shooters by being a voice of reason and understanding when conflict arises. She always supports orderly dialogue to voice differences of opinion and seeks consensus solutions. Kathy's organizational and writing skills have been instrumental in changes made to both ISTA and ID PITA bylaws by sending in proposals to those organization for membership vote.

Kathy's talents spill over to cashiering, too. Since the late 90's, she has done the cashiering for the Culdadesac Gun Club annual ATA shoot and worked as a volunteer "helper" to other cashiers at other gun clubs during their registered shoots. In the early days, all shooter information and scores were recorded on triplicate forms, by hand entry. Cashiering responsibilities were very time consuming and continued several days past the end of the shoot. Kathy was one of the first to purchase and become adept at computer assisted cashiering. In 2006 Kathy partnered with her friend Kathi McCulley and K & K Cashiering was born. In the 16 years they have worked together they have managed to have a little fun and still meet their original goals of providing accuracy for shooters and accountability to the host clubs that hired them. Their cashiering efforts have taken them from the Hawaii State PITA shoot in Hilo to Nez Perce's Father's Day shoot. They have also been regular cashiers at Grangeville shoots. One time, they emergently stepped in to cashier the Camas Prairie Handicap for their friend Steve Eichenberger who was battling cancer at the time. Kathy continues to tirelessly volunteer her time and energy at any shoot she attends and is well known to all the Idaho clubs.



Kathy was born to Luana and Alvin Connerley and has four siblings: Byron (deceased), Dirk, Janene, and Chris. She is married to Spud Storey and they have two children; Connor, Ali (husband Brian Ferry) and two grandchildren, James and Eli. Her family comes before any score or average. Kathy requested to be placed permanently on the 25-yd line for handicap so she could always shoot with her dad. She could have shot much better scores and increased her average but if you know Kathy at all, you understand that the Average Book was not important-- shooting on the same squad as her dad, Alvin, was.

This nomination would be lacking if Kathy's shooting sense of humor wasn't addressed. I have personally witnessed her shoot guns that have bad triggers, jury-rigged, and pieced together guns by her dad or Spud, and guns specifically made for her small stature. She trusts and shoots any shells Spud puts in her pocket. Her goal always is to shoot better than a 2 on a post, break more than half and have fun. These two things alone have brought much laughter over the years. However, I will never forget the first time I met her. I am sure these pins have rendered many humiliating shooting wounds healed when given with Kathy's smile and laugh.

Kathy leads by example by being an honorable sportsman, donating her time, her money and considerable efforts to the people who also enjoy the sport that she loves. She defends their rights and enables shooters to have a voice in the governance of the sport that they love. Entry Fee for this non-compulsory option is \$3.00 each 50 for a total of \$18.00. Entry fees collected at this shoot will be added to the respective purses. Any two 25 straights win one-half of the respective purse. Each \$18.00 entry is eligible for one-half of any or all (i.e. 100 straight) of these purses. All ties divide respective monies.


### **ATA DAILY FEES**

The ATA in its program of building strong state associations, aids them financially; from the \$20 annual membership, \$2 is returned to the state organization. From the \$500 life membership, \$150 is returned to the state organization over a ten (10) year period & part is retained in a special ATA emergency fund. From the \$3 daily fee, twenty percent (20%) is returned to the state organization.

These refunds are made to the State Association ten days prior to the State Tournament, provided such tournament is held and provided the State turns into the ATA at least \$200 from annual membership dues and registration fees. From this refund, there will be deducted an amount equal to any fines due because of late shoot reports. On or before January 1 of each year the ATA shall inform the secretary of each State of the approximate amount of refund to be paid to that state.



## GRANT WILLIAMS

Grant Williams, a Kellogg Idaho native, is a gifted trapshooter. The entire Idaho trapshooting community is proud and in awe of his ability and talent.

Soft-spoken, friendly, humble and hard-working are the common descriptors used to describe Williams by his friends and family — traits anyone would love to have said about them. These traits are not exactly what many expect from a national champion trap shooter.


In August 2022 Williams won the 123rd Grand American Trapshooting High All Around Championship in Sparta, Ill. -- a shoot where more than 3,000 of the best trapshooters in the world compete. The High All-Around championship is the aggregate score of Singles, Handicap and Doubles Championship events. Out of a best possible score of 400, Williams scored 398 — which likely makes him the one of the best trapshooters in the world with a 12-gauge shotgun. Shooters cross the state shooters watched the scores come in during the 2022 Grand American, where Grant represented Idaho. Everyone was ecstatic when he walked away with the 2022 Grand American High All Around Award.

Trapshooting runs deep in the Williams family — both Williams' father Darin and uncle Beaver were talented shooters who got their start from their father, Floyd Williams. The brothers passed this art down to their sons; Beaver to his son, Derek, and Darin to his sons, Grant and Garrett. Darin himself is a member of the Idaho Trapshooting Hall of Fame — a destination that Grant is likely to find himself enshrined as well.

Williams has been shooting competitively since he was 11 years old. He has excelled at the sport since first picking up a shotgun and through the years was known across the state as he picked up most of the Sub Junior and Junior Trophies, and has continued to win many state titles as an adult.

You'll notice that events 2 and 3 of the 2023 Idaho State Championship are named after Grant. That's because the winner of the prior years Champion events is honored with the preliminary event of the subsequent year being named after the winner of the prior year's Champion Events. If you look back at old programs you will note that there are many years of Grant William's Singles, Handicap and Doubles Events.

ISTA congratulates Grant Williams for his great shooting and outstanding representation of Idaho State Trapshooters at the 2022 Grand American. When you see him on the line at this shoot be sure to greet him and extend hearty congratulations as well.




